

## Go green in the hills: Belle Mont Farm

Jo Fernández visits Belle Mont Farm, a collection of 84 one-bedroom adult-only cottages located on the Kittitian Hill of St Kitts

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Less developed than neighbouring Antigua, St Kitts — the larger of its sister island St Nevis — has powder-sand beaches and an 18th-century hilltop fort. Tourism has replaced sugar cane as the main industry. The latest development is Kittitian Hill, a 400-acre development in the north of the island, offering four hotel options with a more environmental edge, among the tropical slopes of Mt Liamuiga, a dormant volcano.

Belle Mont Farm, a collection of 84 one-bedroom adult-only cottages set on the hillside of an organic farm, is the first to open on December 12, designed by Bill Bensley (Four Seasons, Oberoi and Leela hotels).

Each cottage will have an outside shower, iPad and a projector screen. The Kitchen restaurant will serve food from onsite and sustainable farms.
