The luxury Caribbean island of St Kitts is not exactly synonymous with a hand-to-mouth existence. But that's the ethos of a swanky new development, Belle Mont Farm. Guests will be given wooden baskets and encouraged to forage in 400 acres of "edible landscape", packed with exotic fruits and vegetables; the produce will then be used in dishes.
