## GO GREEN IN THE HILLS

**DESTINATION ST KITTS**

LESS developed than neighbouring Antigua, St Kitts - the larger of its sister island St Kitts - has powder sand beaches and an 18th century hilltop fort. Tourism has replaced sugar cane as the main industry. The latest development is British Hill, a 100-acre development in the north of the island, offering four hotel options with a more environmental edge.

Among the tropical slopes of Mt. Liamuiga, a dormant volcano, is Zelle Moon Farm, a collection of 84 one-bedroom adult-only cottages set on the hillside of an organic farm, is the first to open on December 12, designed by Hill Country (from Sotheby's, Obamas and Lads) hotels.

Each cottage will have an outside shower, iPad and a private screen. The kitchen restaurant will serve food from organic and sustainable farms.

WE recently booked a long weekend to Madrid with BA for later this month but feel uncomfortable about the confirmation of Ebola there. We believe we should be responsible about travelling - both for our own health and what we might bring back to the UK. We are not seeking a refund (unless it's possible) and would be happy to travel somewhere else, or change the dates. What do you advise? - Gail Martin

OCTOBER is an ideal time to visit Madrid, with the summer heat dwindling and before winter takes a grip. While Summers enough to be going, I would be concerned about too being the sometimes reckless driving you encounter and the high incidence of street crime.

I don't imagine you are planning to visit the capital's hospitals for infectious diseases and please yourself in close proximity to the colleagues of the unfortunate those who contracted Ebola to change locally. I also presume that you'll take the normal basic health precautions for any trip - certainly keeping your hands clean and washing them before meals, in which case, I cannot see any possible risk.

BA will not make rebooking conditions for travellers going to Spain or Africa for medical examinations or so-called, and I can see no reason why it should.
