The glossy mag has completed its annual survey of the planet's best new stays, compiling them for its annual hotel "[Hot List](#)."

As usual, the selection includes a varied mix of uber-cool urban hangouts crawling with selfie-snapping celebrities and luxurious getaways far from the city glitz.

Conde Nast Traveler sorts these into categories including hotels it considers best for bargains, beaches, urban standouts, design, families, food, luxury and remote wilderness.
