On the farm in the Caribbean

Indulge your family in green luxury. Stay in one of the gorgeous new guesthouses at the Belle Mont Farm, the first phase of the Kittitian Hill eco-resort in St Kitts, and you can send the children off each morning to pick passion fruit, bananas and pineapples from the estate, then hop on bikes to cycle down to the beach. You'll have to wait until the end of the year, though, for the opening of The Village, which will have a weekly farmers' market, street food stalls, galleries, a film school and an open-air cinema.
