THIS WINTER A SPARKLING NEW MINI-RIVIERA WILL BE BORN ON NASSAU IN THE BAHAMAS. Offering white-sand beaches and a Jack Nicklaus Signature golf course, the 2,200-room **Baha Mar** resort (bahamar.com) features hotels from such leading names as Rosewood, SLS Lux and Grand Hyatt, along with more than 40 restaurants, a casino and a Lenny Kravitz-designed nightclub. Further south, Anguilla is blessed with some of the best beaches in the Caribbean. Set on a panoramic bluff overlooking Maids Bay, the 46-room **Molokaha Hotel & Spa** (molokahotel.com) reopened in this month following an extensive redesign by new owners Auberge.

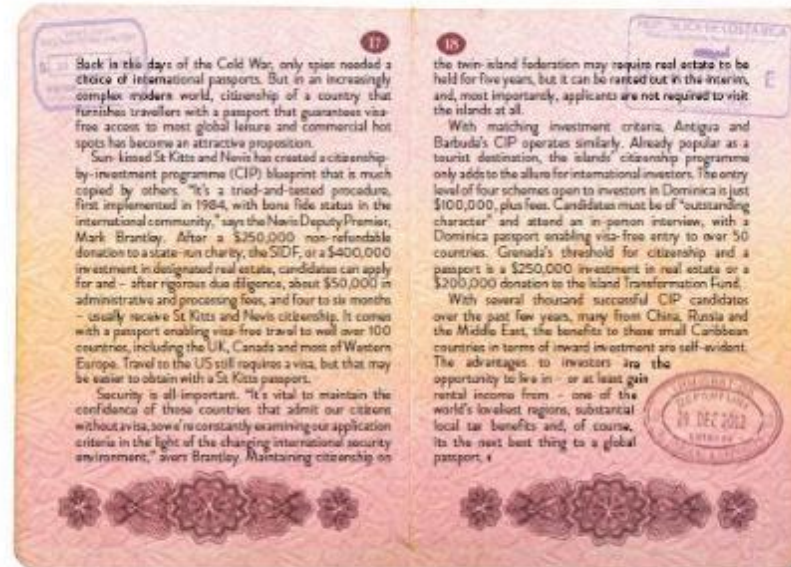
Resorts - treats include ocean-view suites decorated with Haitian artwork and a two-tier infinity pool with private cabanas. For those who prefer exploring to flopping, St Kitts has rich historic attractions that include the monumental Brimstone Hill Fortress, a World Heritage site, and a delightful coastal railway left from the days of sugar. Opening on 12 December, **Bello Meets Farm** (bellomeetsfarm.com) is a Bill Bensley-designed island hideaway with 84 guesthouses and seven four-bedroom villas set on the grass slopes of Mt Liamuiga. Sustainability is the priority here, with a chemical-free golf course and an organic farm delivering fresh fruit to your veranda each morning.
